Job Description:

This part-time position would be supporting the efforts of Cal Poly Humboldt's Place-Based Learning Communities (PBLCs). Under the supervision of the PBLC staff, Ambassadors will assist in welcoming incoming students to Cal Poly Humboldt during the "Welcome Week" programs that will begin on Monday, August 19th.

The PBLCs are for first-time freshmen at Cal Poly Humboldt. Each PBLC has its own unique set of hands-on field trips and activities that students engage in during a five-day Welcome Week program. Welcome Week is designed to welcome students to Cal Poly Humboldt, introduce them to their majors / interests, and to connect them to faculty, staff, and their peers.

Pay Rate & Time Commitment:

These positions pay \$17.00 - \$19.00 per hour depending on experience. This role will have mandatory in-person training from Monday, August 12th to Friday, August 16th. Training will be between two and four hours. An exact schedule will be sent out in early August.

The Ambassadors will be expected to work 8 hours on average from Monday, August 12th to Friday, August 16th. Specific Ambassador itineraries are TBD and will be sent out in August and covered in training. These are state-funded positions.

Expected Duties:

Participate in required student-staff training. Assist in welcoming incoming freshmen to Cal Poly Humboldt. Attend activities during Welcome Week and support the team of student-staff to ensure students are prepared for events each day. Complete logistical tasks and help the Welcome Week staff and PBLC faculty as needed.
